Genome: Unlocking Life's Code April 1 – May 29, 2017

Genome: Unlocking Life's Code celebrates the Human Genome Project's landmark achievement—the first complete sequencing of the human genetic code. Advances in technology led to a revolution in genomic research that resulted in the complete sequencing of the human genome in 2003. That revolution continues today in the application of genomics to our understanding of human health, ourselves, and the natural world.

The George & Norma Kottemann Collection: A 40-Year Passion for Art April 8 – July 9, 2017

Featuring 45 works of mid-century to contemporary art, this remarkable exhibition traces one couple's journey as collectors through four decades of discovery, appreciation and patronage of the arts. The exhibition showcases prints, paintings, and other works on paper by ground-breaking artists including Georgia O'Keeffe, Marc Chagall, Alexander Calder and others. More than a dozen sculptural works will be on view by visionary artists including Preston Jackson and Willem de Kooning. Also included is a selection of sculptural glass that traces the history of the studio art glass movement in America.
