## HOME CARE SERVICES

Snyder Village is pleased to offer home care services to the residents of Woodford, Marshall, Tazewell and Peoria counties to enhance and prolong independent living. We provide non-medical home care services that are affordable and dependable. Snyder Village's home care programs can provide long-term assistance with daily living activities, short-term assistance after a surgery or hospital stay, or 24-hour care.

## RETIREMENT COMMUNITY

Snyder Village Retirement Community offers maintenance-free living, independent cottages and apartments. There are 39 apartments and 170 cottages located on our beautiful campus. Potential residents have a choice of several different cottage designs that range from 900 to 1,900 square feet. Customization options are also available. ## ASSISTED LIVING

Snyder Village Assisted Living offers 65 studio, one- and two-bedroom apartments. Assisted living is perfect for individuals who wish to keep their independence, yet still need some level of assistance. With 20 of our studio apartments dedicated to memory care, we can now serve residents with early to mid-stage dementia and Alzheimer's. ## HEALTH CENTER

The Snyder Village Health Center offers 104 beds for long-term care and short-term recovery following hospitalization. Our dementia special care neighborhood has 27 beds to serve residents with mid- to late-stage dementia and Alzheimer's. The Health Center is recognized for its high nursing staff-to-resident ratio, and all of the beds are Medicare- and Medicaid-certified.
